



## Victory and double podium at home race

Once again the team set of to the largest racing event in Scandinavia, Swedish Sportscarmeeting at Ring Knutstorp. The twitchy circuit with lots of elevations is not ideal for a Healey and is very demanding for the driver with no time to rest.

Qualifying in dry conditions went well and driver Anders put the Healey third on grid behind the Jaguar E-type on pole and second placed Lotus Elan.



The skies opened up a few hours before the race and Anders was up to 2nd at the first corner and passed the leading Jaguar after less than a lap. "It doesn't matter if it is wet or dry, I always give it all I got" said Anders.

The Lotus Elan of Bengt-Åke Bengtsson appeared in the mirrors after a few laps but the Healey took the flag as 1st.



"We are very happy with the result. There has been a spell on this race event and we have never reached the podium before due to either technical problems or bad luck" said team manager for the weekend – Erik Rydåker-Lindberg.

The second race started from 2nd on grid and after one lap the Healey led the race. Being in dry conditions the Jaguar E-type and Lotus Elans that failed in the rain in Race 1 and had started further back started to catch up.



"There wasn't much I could do. Tyres and brakes gets very hot on this circuit especially on a sunny day" – commented Anders.

Third place, second podium for the weekend and an average result of 2nd was an achievement compared to the team's main opponents averaging 7th.
