



Race Victory and a Double Podium at the Seasons Opener!

The team made a near perfect start to the 2009 season at Sturup Raceway with a double podium ... second in race one, and outright victory in race two. Qualifying second just 0.7 seconds behind Rolf "Myggran" Nilsson in his Lotus 26(R), we made a good start in the first race holding second place to the flag - 8 seconds behind the Lotus.

Due to a malfunctioning transponder in the first race we were forced to start from the back of the grid for the second race ... and on top of this it had started to rain! "Starting from the back of the grid in the wet is not always easy, and it can get messy in front of you, said driver Anders."

After two spectacular laps the Healey led the race, and as the chequered flag fell we were 7 seconds ahead of the second placed Lotus ... The first outright victory for 2009

The teams' development of the Healey over the winter was proven to be very successful at Sturup Raceway. The car now handles better than ever, but there is still room for more improvement. The engine feels strong and flexible pulling from 4000 rpm and is still delivering its power at 7500 rpm.

Next Race - Gelleråsen 12-14th of June

With no problems after the races at Sturup Raceway, the team will do a full mechanical check so that the Healey is fully prepared for Gelleråsen.
